



Chelodina Master Fund – Responsible Investment

The Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation (“SFDR”) comes into force on the 10th of March 2021, investments underlying the Fund do not take into account the EU criteria for environmentally sustainable economic activities. The classification of the Funds as an Article 6 Fund means that the Fund does not promote environmental or social characteristics in a way that meets the specific criteria contained in Article 8 of SFDR or have sustainable investment as their objective in a way that meets the specific criteria contained in Article 9 of SFDR. Accordingly, the Fund does not deem Sustainability Risks to be relevant and does not integrate Sustainability Risks into its investment decisions due to the investment strategy of the Funds. Accordingly, the Investment Manager does not expect that Sustainability Risks will materially impact the expected risk or return characteristics of the Fund.
